# FREDERICKSBURG UMPIRES ASSOCIATION 3-UMPIRE BASEBALL MECHANICS SUMMARY

## NO RUNNERS ON BASE

- *Positioning* **U1** in **A** Position, **U3** in **D** position. (Both umpires 10-12 feet behind baseman, in foul territory, and no closer than 10 feet to the base)
- Fair/Foul **U1** calls right field line, **U3** calls left field line.
- Catch/No Catch Centerfielder coming straight in or toward right field line is **U1**, Centerfielder towards left field line is the **U3**.
- *Base Hits* **U1** pivots to inside, has runner at 1st. **U3** pivots to **C** position, has runner advancing to 2<sup>nd</sup>, **Plate** rotates to 3<sup>rd</sup> and has runner advancing to 3<sup>rd</sup>, **U1** rotates to plate, and has runner coming home.
- *Trouble balls* If **U1** goes out on a fly ball, **Plate Umpire** follows the batter/runner, **U3** pivots to **C** position and has runner to 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. If **U3** goes out, revert to standard 2-man mechanic.
- *Overthrows at first* **Plate** follows the ball, **U1** focus on the runner, **U3** takes position **C** for runner to 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- *Three foot running lane* **Plate Umpire** watch for possible interference by runner.

#### **RUNNER ON FIRST**

- *Positioning* **U1** in **A** Position, **U3** in **B** position.
- Fair/Foul **U1** has right field line, **Plate** has left field line.
- Catch/No Catch **U3** inside the V, **U1** has right fielder to right field line, **Plate** has left fielder to left field line.
- *Pick-off at First Base* **U1** has runner.
- Base hit Plate Umpire rotates to third for runner advance, U3 covers second, U1 rotates to plate after runners clear first.
- Steal of Second Base U3 has call at second, and follows runner to third on overthrows.

### **RUNNER ON SECOND**

- *Positioning* **U1** in **B** position, **U3** in **D** position.
- Fair/Foul Plate has right field line, U3 has left field line.
- Catch/No Catch **U1** inside the V, **U3** has left fielder to left field line, **Plate** has right fielder to right field line.
- Base Hit Plate has runner to first, then returns to home. U1 covers second, U3 covers third.
- *Pick-off at Second Base* **U1** has runner.
- *Steal of Third Base* **U3** has full coverage.

## RUNNERS ON FIRST & SECOND; RUNNERS ON FIRST & THIRD

- *Positioning* **U1** in **A** position, **U3** in **C** position; **B** or **C** for 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Fair/Foul Plate has the left field line, **U1** has the right field line.
- Catch/No Catch **U3** inside the **V**, **U1** right fielder to right field line, **Plate** left fielder to left field line.
- *Tag-up* **U3** has the lead runner (2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup>), and **U1** has runner at first Signal and communicate.
- Infield fly (First & Second only) Signal and Communicate. Any Umpire can call the Infield Fly Rule, partners should mirror it.
- Base Hit U3 rotates to C, Plate rotates to 3<sup>rd</sup>, U1 rotates to Home.
- *Pick-offs* **U1** has runner at first, **U3** has runner at 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Steal of Second or Third Base **U3** has runner stealing.

## RUNNERS ON SECOND AND THIRD OR BASES LOADED

- *Positioning* **U1** in **B** position, **U3** in **D** position.
- Fair/Foul **U3** has left field line, **Plate** has right field line.
- *Catch/No Catch* **U1** inside the V, **U3** from left fielder to left field line, **Plate** from right fielder to right field line.
- Tag-up On balls hit to left field, **Plate** has lead runner, **U1** has trailing runner(s). On balls hit to right field, **U3** has lead runner, **U1** has trailing runner(s), on balls hit into the V, **U3** has lead runner and **Plate** has trailing runner(s). Signal and communicate.
- *Infield fly (Bases Loaded only)* Signal and Communicate. Any Umpire can call the Infield Fly Rule, partners should mirror it.

\*Check Swings – **Plate Umpire** has the option of asking for assistance on check swings by batter. **Plate** may appeal to **U1** in positions **A** or **B** for a right-handed batter, or to **U3** in positions **C** or **D** for a left-handed batter. Coach and Catcher do not have appeal authority in high school baseball.
